Please note the following final instructions which will help you and your team to have an enjoyable weekend in Mallow and help the organisers to run a safe and enjoyable event.

2. Competitors who have not yet finalised payment details are required to contact the entries secretary, Trisha Hogan, before Friday 26<sup>th</sup> July to arrange payment.

3. The time and distance schedule is available on request only to competitors entered in the event. Please forward your request to [trishahogan13@gmail.com](mailto:trishahogan13@gmail.com)
4. Mechanical Scrutiny is located at EARS Motorsport in Quartertown Industrial Estate Mallow on Friday July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019. A google map link has been provided on the Jim Walsh Cork Forest Rally Facebook page and [www.corkmotorclub.com](http://www.corkmotorclub.com) illustrating the location.  
Scrutiny opens at 16:00 and closes at 20:00 sharp –Please be on time.
5. The trailer park is located at the Dairygold contractor car park on Park Road Malow (Last years’ service area) – see google map link. Trailers must be parked in the designated area – please co-operate with our marshals. Trailers are parked at owner’s risk and the club takes no responsibility for damage or loss to trailers in the trailer park. **No trailers will be allowed in the Parc Ferme area.**
6. Documentation scrutiny takes place on Friday July 26<sup>th</sup> from **16:30 to 20:30**. Documentation scrutiny is located in the Cork County Council offices adjacent to Parc Ferme. Please be on time and have all relevant documentation to hand – No IRDS/BRDS and or Licence – No Start

7. Documentation scrutiny and Parc Ferme are all located at The Cork County Council offices at Annabella Mallow. Please enter through the Dairygold roundabout off the N20. This will be arrowed. Again, please see the google map link.
8. There will be a service after cars leave Parc Ferme on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup> before cars head for SS1. Please note that there is no service in control at this service and the total time allowed (25 mins) is from Parc Ferme to the service out control (3.3km).
9. The Saturday service area is located in Quartertown Industrial Estate Mallow (see event google map link). The Saturday service area will open at 8am on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup>. All service vehicles must display their service sticker – no sticker no access. A one-way system will be in operation in the Saturday service area with the service out control located near the exit of the industrial estate.  
The Sunday service area is located in the Mallow Autograss Racing Facility, Quitrentmountain, Ballyguyroe, Co. Cork (see google map link). The Sunday service area will be open from 19:00 on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup> and overnight security will be provided. Ground sheets must be used in both service areas at all times – no ground sheet – no service. Please work with and cooperate with our marshals in the service areas.
10. Detailed A3 sized route maps will be available to competitors to purchase at documentation scrutiny.
11. Applications for reseeding must be submitted at documentation scrutiny on Friday July 26<sup>th</sup> by no later than 21:00 – **no applications for reseed will be accepted after this time or on Saturday morning – if you wish to apply for a reseed – you must apply on the Friday night.** Applications must be made on the official reseeding application forms available at documentation scrutiny.
12. Competitors safety briefing will take place at 09:00 on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup> at the Fire Station adjacent to Parc Ferme – please be on time. The J1000 briefing will take place at 08:45 at the same location
13. First Car away from MC1 on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup> is 10:01 – a starters list and times will be published in Parc Ferme on the morning of the event.
14. The official notice board will be located in documentation scrutiny on Friday July 26<sup>th</sup> and the Rally HQ – The Hibernian Hotel for the remainder of the event.
15. Prizegiving will take place at the finish arch in Parc Ferme on Sunday July 28<sup>th</sup> as per event regulations
