



Final Instructions 2

1. Competitors Safety - Safety Tracking System

As part of the Motorsport Ireland test on tracking all cars will be fitted with the Safety Tracking System (STS) device for day 2 of the Jim Walsh Cork Forestry Rally 2019. The STS devices will be distributed at Parc Ferme out control on Sunday morning the 28th. In preparation for this, at Parc Ferme in control on Saturday evening the 27th, each competitor will be asked to surrender the competition licence of one of the crew and this will be held by way of deposit and returnable upon timely and undamaged return of the device. All crews must declare the number of the mobile phone of both crew members which they will carry on board and maintain in the 'ON' state during the entire event. This will allow the organisers to contact any crew that stops in the stage to verify they are ok. In the event of a crew requiring medical services, in addition to using the normal protocol of the next crew going to the next radio point, you may also use the tracker to alert the services by pressing twice on the SOS button on the tracker.

The STS device will be collected at the Parc Ferme In Control (Final Control) by Sporttraxx personnel.

In the event of retirement, the STS device must be returned to Sporttraxx personnel at Service Out Control during the day or at the Parc Ferme In Control at the conclusion of the event where your licence will be returned. contact phone number 087 8238405.

2. Change to published list of officials:

- Update to published supplementary regulations, Article 11 as follows:

RE-START AFTER RETIRING ON LEG 1:

11.1.2.1 A crew retiring from the rally between Parc Ferme Out and Arrival Control SS2, may restart the rally from Service Out Control after 2, or 4 stages, or from Overnight Parc Ferme Out Control (subject to compliance with 11.1.3 below).

Cars retiring from the rally on Special Stages 2 or 3, or the following road sections, may restart from Service Out Control after 4 stages, or from Overnight Parc Ferme Out Control. (subject to compliance with 11.1.3 below).

Cars retiring from the rally on Special Stages 4 or 5 or 6, or the following road sections, may only restart from Overnight Parc Ferme Out Control. (subject to compliance with 11.1.3 below).

If they are unable to re-start at Service Out Control after 2, or 4 stages they must have their car in Parc Ferme not later than 22.00 hours on Saturday night. They may then restart, subject to passing scrutiny, on Leg 2 at Overnight Parc Ferme Out Control if they are to continue to be classified in overall results.

- When competing cars enter/ are placed in overnight Parc Ferme at the end of leg 1 (Saturday 27th July) they may Not be removed before their due time at Parc Ferme out control/ Start of leg 2 Sunday morning 28th July.
