- The event is an open competition and will be a navigation trial type event held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland, Appendices 33, 34 of the current Motorsport Ireland Yearbook, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event. M.I. Permit No: **23/003**
- The event will be run according to the relevant regulations published in the current Year Book of Motorsport Ireland as revised by Motor Sport Bulletin and any amendments of the regulations published by MI. Entrants are advised to check the MI website in this regard, as there may be some recent changes. Entrants are reminded that the event will be governed by the requirements of App 33/34 as current at the time of the event. A copy of any revisions will be posted at sign-on, and they will also be available on the MI website.
- Route will be approximately 110 miles in length. Petrol will be required for 70 miles. Nearest filling station to HQ is 24-hour Circle K on N22 c. 3km SE of Macroom. The Route will be defined by Controls, time points and vias each of which must be visited in the order stated. Grid references will, in general, be including used to give location and required approach and departure of the required points will also be given. Other methods as permitted by Appendix 33 may be used to identify the location and required approach and departure of a limited number of points. Additional explanatory diagrams may be given for complicated junction layouts.
- Maps used: OSI Discovery Series, Sheets 79 (4th Edition) & 80 (5th Edition),
- Documentation check-in will be from 18.00, and mechanical scrutiny will be from 19.00 on Saturday, 20th January 2024 at Aghinagh GAA Hall (378766).. Parking restrictions will be in place at the venue, with an **important and particular prohibition of parking of any vehicle or trailer on grass**, and competitors and any vehicle associated with a competitor must park as directed. Excessive noise will not be allowed. The Stewards will be asked to approve a penalty for non-compliance with these parking & noise requirements as per 21.24 of App 33.
- Any crew who have not completed paperwork by 1900 and/or have not passed Mechanical Scrutiny by 20.00 on Saturday 20th February 2024 will not be allowed start the event. Where prior notification of a difficulty with this requirement is given and at the sole discretion of the organisers, this rule may be relaxed. Route card 1 will be issued at 19.00. Route Card 2 & timecards will be issued not later than 20.30 but in the case of **up to 8 points** (4 before & 4 after Petrol) the locations & required route may be issued to competitors at a later time. First Competing Car starts at **22.01**.
- Awards:** 1st overall (Perpetual Trophy & 2 Replicas). 1st, 2nd & 3rd in class (2 Trophies). Best Cork MC Crew (2 Trophies).
- Classes:** Expert, Semi-Expert, Novice, Beginner as per M.I. Regulations.
- Entries:** Entries close on Thursday 18th January 2024. €175 entry fee includes Competitors Personal Accident Insurance & IRDS (Under 18s pay €7 less). All competitors must have a valid Competition Licence and all drivers must have valid IRDS cover, Remember NO IRDS NO START. Maximum number of starters is 50.

Only paid-up entries accepted. Entries must be submitted online at www.corkmotorclub.com on our online shop. On Completion of online entry, please complete and sign the Entry form, and send back to entries Secretary via email or WhatsApp.
