- The event is an open competition and will be a navigation trial type event held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the General Competition Rules of Motorsport Ireland, Appendices 33, 34 of the Motorsport Ireland, these supplementary regulations and any final instructions issued before the start of the event. M.I. Permit No: **26/141**.
- The event will be run according to the relevant regulations published in the 2026 Yearbook of Motorsport Ireland as revised by Motor Sport Bulletin and any amendments of those regulations published by MI. Entrants are advised to check the MI website in this regard.
- Sportity password **Startrek26**.
- Route will be approximately 80 miles in length. Petrol will be required for 80 miles. Nearest filling station to HQ is East Cork Oil in Rathcormac (not 24hr) (806.5/912), Maxol in Midleton (not 24hr) (879.5/739.5) & Certa 24-hr Midleton (876/736). Controls, time points and vias will define the route generally, which must be visited in the order stated. Grid references will, in general, be used to give location and required approach and departure at the required points will also be given. Other methods as permitted by Appendix 33 may be used to identify the locations and required approach and departure of a limited number of points. Additional diagrams may be given for complicated junction layouts. The route for Speed Regulation Sections will be given in greater detail as required by Appendix 33
- Maps used: OSI Discovery Series, Sheet 81 (5th Edition).
- Documentation check-in will be from **18.30**, and mechanical scrutiny will be from **19.00** on Saturday, 17th October 2026 at Lisgoold Community Hall, Lisgoold (852/802). The trailer park will be at Lisgoold GAA Club (852.5/806). Dedicated parking at the venue for all competing cars. All vehicles associated with competitors and marshals and members of the public must park so as not to cause obstruction. Excessive noise will not be allowed. The Stewards will be asked to approve a penalty for non-compliance with these parking & noise requirements as per 21.24 of App 33.

7. Any crew who have not completed paperwork by **20.00** and/or have not passed Mechanical Scrutiny by **20.00** on Saturday 17th October 2026 will not be allowed start the event. Where prior notification of a difficulty with this requirement is given and at the sole discretion of the organisers, this rule may be relaxed. Route card 1 and timecards will be issued at **19.30**. Route Card 2 will be issued not later than **20.30** but in the case of **up to 6 points** the locations & required route may be issued to competitors at a later time. First Competing Car starts at **22.01**.

8. **Awards:** 1st overall, (Perpetual Trophy & 2 Replicas). 1st, 2nd and 3rd in class (2 Trophies). Best Cork Motor Club Crew (2 Trophies). See also below re sub-1400 cc Cars

9. **Classes:** Expert, Semi-Expert, Novice, Beginner as per M.I. Regulations. In addition, the top 3 finishing crews of crews of cars of less than 1400cc will be given awards

10. **Entries:** Entries close on Wednesday 14th October 2026. €175 entry fee includes Competitors Personal Accident Insurance & IRDS (Under 18s pay €7 less). All competitors must have a valid Competition Licence and all drivers must have IRDS cover. Remember NO IRDS NO START. Maximum number of starters is 50.

Only paid-have IRDS accepted. Entries must be submitted online at www.corkmotorclub.com on our online shop.

*** IMPORTANT – COMPETITORS UNDER 18**

Competitors under 18 years of age (Minor) must be entered in the event by the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence who must countersign the entry form. A Minor Entrant who is not the parent/legal guardian of the Minor, must be Garda Vetted. Where an adult sits in the same car as a Minor competitor, the adult must be the holder of a Minor Entrant Licence, if they are not the Minor's Parent/Legal Guardian this licence must include Garda Vetting. It is not permitted to have two minors in the same vehicle
